



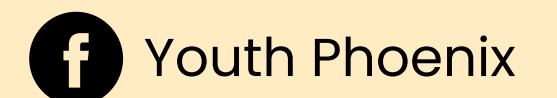

EUROPEAN SOLIDARITY CORPS - SOLIDARITY PROJECTS

These programs emphasize community and solidarity and are perfect for young individuals or associations with no prior experience in implementing funded projects.

Priorities:

1. Inclusion and Diversity.
2. Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development.
3. Digital Transformation.

Project Duration: 2-12 months

Informal groups (minimum 5 young people between 18-30 years old) and NGOs can apply.

Budget:

- 595 EUR per month for all activities and management.
- 74 EUR per coach per day, maximum 12 days.

PROGRAMUL ERASMUS+

The Erasmus+ program is divided into three key actions (Key Action – KA):

KA1 – LEARNING MOBILITY OF INDIVIDUALS

KA2 – COOPERATION ALONG INSTITUTIONS AND ORGANIZATIONS

KA3 – SUPPORT TO POLICY DEVELOPMENT AND COOPERATION

KA1 - DISCOVER EU INCLUSION

This program is designed to assist young people aged 18 with limited opportunities to travel and have a non-formal learning experience.

1-5 young people traveling in Europe by train for a maximum of 30 days (with a maximum of 7 days for actual travel).

Informal groups (minimum 5 young people aged 18-30) and NGOs can apply.
Multiple journeys can be undertaken within the project.
A group leader/facilitator can accompany the journey.

Budget:

- 7 days free travel pass
 - - 70 EUR per day - Individual Support



KA1 - YOUTH EXCHANGES AND TRAINING COURSES

Youth exchanges are meetings between groups of young people from at least two different countries who come together for a short period with the aim of jointly implementing a program of non-formal learning (a mix of workshops, exercises, debates, role-playing, simulations, outdoor activities, etc.) on a subject of interest.

Priorities:

- Inclusion and Diversity.
- Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development.
- Digital Transformation.
- Participation in democratic life.

Organizations from the public or private sector can apply.

Groups of at least 5 young people (including the group leader) can participate.

Duration: 3-24 months.

KA1 - YOUTH EXCHANGES AND TRAINING COURSES

Budget:

- 100 EUR/participant - Organizational Support.
- 32 EUR/day - Individual Support (provided based on the country).
- Transport - according to the distance band.
- 100 EUR/participant - Inclusion Support.

DIFFERENCES BETWEEN YOUTH EXCHANGE AND TRAINING COURSE

KA1 - YOUTH PARTICIPATION ACTIVITIES

These projects support young people's participation in the democratic life of Europe at the national, regional, or local level.

Priorities:

- Inclusion and Diversity.
- Environmental Protection and Sustainable Development.
- Digital Transformation.
- Participation in democratic life.

Project Duration: 3-24 months.

Informal groups (minimum 5 young people between 18-30 years old), NGOs, and public institutions can apply.

Projects can have national or transnational partners.

Budget:

- 500 EUR/month - management.
- 100 EUR/participant - for each activity.
 - - 100 EUR/participant - Inclusion Support. + mobility budget (as it is in youth exchange)

KA2 - SMALL SCALE COOPERATION

- Digital Transformation.
- Participation in democratic life.

Project Duration: 3-24 months.
